Dear Sportsman:

Hunting season is right around the corner at Dead Man's Pass Ranch! It's time to get out those dusty guns and get them all cleaned up and ready to go. If you don't own a hunting rifle here are some things to consider when purchasing one.

First off, decide what you will be using it for. The rifle, cartridge and scope choices will be specific for the type of game you will be hunting and the size and model you select will depend on your strength, frame and experience. Finding the perfect rifle is mostly a matter of personal preference and what you are comfortable with.

Most deer hunting is done usually less than 100 yards or so but there are times when shots will be taken from 200 yards and beyond. There is a great variety of makes and models and they vary mainly to the caliber and cartridge sizes.

When looking for a rifle there are a few things to be taken into consideration.

- **TYPE OF RIFLE**

This will be determined based on the area and type of game you will be hunting.

- **BALANCE**

Be particular about the balance of the hunting rifle. It must be in perfect balance to shoot accurately.

- **BARREL LENGTH**

A shorter barrel is lightweight, more maneuverable and will result in a quicker shot. The shorter barrel works well when you are hunting in heavy brush and shooting at running game but also results in a loss of velocity and stability.

Some hunters prefer long range rifles which are commended for accuracy. However, they tend to be heavier and if you are going to be carrying this rifle over rough terrain and long distances, you may want to consider purchasing a lightweight stalking rifle instead.

You might also consider purchasing a tactical rifle scope. It will bring distant targets and surrounding objects up close and personal which will result in more accurate shooting. It is also beneficial when shooting in low light conditions or shooting longer ranges. A few things to take into consideration when buying a scope are price, durability, power settings, adjustments and low light capabilities.

Ask a professional gunsmith for advice. Ask for specific information and his recommendations on both a rifle and scope that are right for your hunting needs. Make sure there is a guarantee or a return policy. Take your new rifle to a gun range to try it out a few times and if you are not comfortable with it, return it. Avoid making impulsive decisions and carefully consider all options.

And last, but not least, always handle your rifle with care and take all necessary precautions. Always keep out of the reach of children and never let them handle unsupervised. A gun lock is also recommended. Check with your police department or your local gunsmith - most of them will give you a gun lock for free!

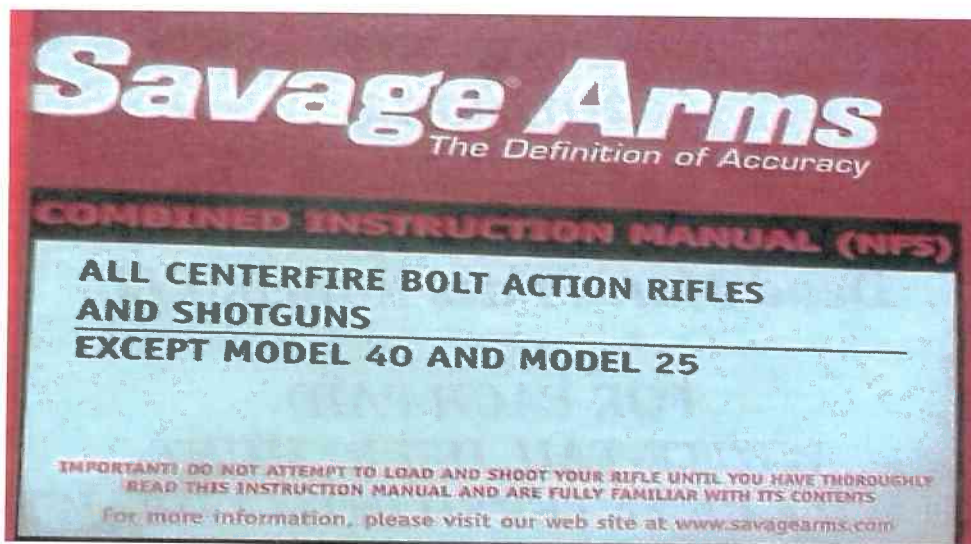
